


ZONA FERENCE CAMP MEETING PROGRAM

CAMP MEETING INFORMATION

A COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF CAMP YAVAPINES POLICIES IS POSTED ON THE BULLETIN BOARD NEXT TO THE REGISTRATION OFFICE.

Accommodations - Individuals must be married or at least 21 years of age to request accommodations. Guests younger than 21 may stay in a cabin/RV/tent space if a supervising adult (21 or older) occupies the same cabin or space. One family per tent space. Violators will be asked to leave. No bunk beds are to be removed. Only small refrigerators may be brought to camp meeting. Do not leave refrigerators in cabins upon departure.

Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco, Firearms or Weapons - Not allowed on Camp Yavapines property. (Includes paint guns and water guns.) Confiscated items will not be returned.

All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV) - <u>Not allowed</u> on Camp Yavapines property.

Bicycles - Cyclists must remain outside of the "Blue Zone." Upon arrival submit a completed "Hold Harmless Agreement" to the Registration Office.

Cafeteria Meals - Served Daily:

Breakfast - 7:15-8:00 AM

Lunch - 12:15-1:15 PM

Supper - 5:30-6:30 PM

Meal Tickets are required and must be purchased in advance at the Registration Office. Adults **\$15**; Ages 6-12 **\$10**, Ages 5 & younger eat for free.

---Snack Shop - Open daily on the east side of Arizona Room. Hours are posted.

Children's Registration - All children in Cradle Roll through Primary need to be registered by parent/guardian at the Children's Registration Booth.

Children and Youth - Parents must supervise their children at all times. Youth and children are not permitted to reside at Camp Yavapines without a parent or guardian present.

Cooking - No open flame of any kind is allowed. Coleman-type stoves fueled by propane can be used if closely monitored.

Dress - Should be in good taste, modest and appropriate.

Electricity - Overuse could result in blown fuses etc. Use judiciously. Electric vehicles <u>can not</u> be charged on property.

First Aid - Is available at the Roadrunner complex 9 AM - 5 PM. After hours is on an on-call basis. Medical treatment is also available at Dignity Health Yavapai Regional Medical Center West.

Golf Carts - Only used by those with a valid driver's license and have it available upon request. **SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH**. Be courteous and considerate for the safety of others. Management reserves the right to suspend driving privileges. Upon arrival please submit a

"Golf Cart Agreement" and proof of liability insurance to the Registration Office.

Hoverboards, Roller Blades, Roller Skates, Skateboards, One wheels, **Drones** - <u>Not allowed</u> on Camp Yavapines property.

Keys - Cabin keys must be returned to the Registration Office at departure. There will be a charge of \$15 for unreturned keys.

Lost & Found - Located at the Registration Office

Mail - Outgoing mail may be left at the Registration Office daily for the Post Office.

Messages - Please check bulletin board outside the Registration Office daily for messages and announcements.

Parking - For guests not staying at Camp Yavapines, parking is available by the main entrance. Guests staying at Camp Yavapines are allowed only one vehicle at their residence site. Those who do not comply may be asked to move their vehicles. Absolutely **No Parking** in the **"Blue Zone"**.

Prayer Ministries - Meets 2:30 - 3:30 PM each day in the Prayer Chapel.

Quiet Time - 10:00 PM - 6:00 AM.

Security - Available 24 hours a day. Contact staff at the Registration Office during office hours. After hours call the posted emergency camp # **(928) 458-1358.**



Pet Policy

- All pets must be registered, \$50 non refundable pet deposit paid and waivers signed and submitted at Registration Office upon arrival.
- <u>Leashes are mandatory</u> when outside participant lodging. Pet owner will be provided with a leash sleeve that is required to be worn. A pet shall always be on leash or in a confined environment. Pets are not permitted to roam free at any time.
- Clean up after your pet. Participants are responsible for cleaning lodging from pet messes, hair, etc. upon departure.
- **Blue Zone** pets are not allowed in the main meeting area.
